Widows and Orphans Village

Idlib, Syria

Supporting over 3 million people in Syria

In September 2018, an estimated 13 million people were in need of humanitarian assistance, and 5.2 million in acute need.

Widows and orphans village 2019 update

We are pleased to announce block A has been completed. Work has started on block B and will be completed in the coming months. Once completed the complex will house 36 families.

Each home is fully furnished with carpets, sofas, beds, heaters, washing machine and a Gas cooker. The village provides the following facilities:

- Free Health care
- Solar water station providing clean water and electricity
- Prayer and Educational facilities
- Women's empowerment centre
- Clothing and Grocery Store
- Youth centre

Ghouta appeal

Eastern Ghouta is a suburb in Damascus which was under siege from 2012. By March 2018 more than 400,000 people needed emergency aid as the situation became critical. Neighbourhoods were completely destroyed claiming hundreds of lives. People were denied food, clean water and medical aid.

One Nation distributed emergency aid to those who needed it the most which included families, widows and orphans. We constructed underground shelters to keep families safe from aerial bombardments.

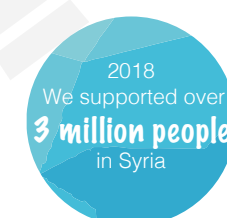
Daraa Displacement

In July 2018, One Nation launched an emergency appeal to assist people in Daraa. People were fleeing their homes due to air strikes. More than 200,000 people were displaced and living in makeshift tents in Quneitra with insufficient food, water or medical care.

One Nation assisted hundreds of families by distributing food aid.

Ramadan in Syria

In the Islamic month of Ramadan, we provided daily hot iftar meals, food parcels, fresh bread, potatoes and clean water to over 250,000 people. The beneficiaries were displaced families in rural Aleppo, Latakia, Hama, Daraa and Idlib.



Civil war in Yemen

Yemen's health system has almost collapsed, the world's largest cholera outbreak has killed thousands of innocent people. One Nation is providing monthly food

parcels, clean water and medical aid in areas of Taiz, Hudaydah, Sana'a, Aden, Ibb and Hajjah.



Family of Fadl Abdo Mohamed Hassan

Fadl Abdo Mohammed Hassan and his family fled from Al-Hudaydah to Taiz to escape the war. He has 5 children, one of them has a serious genetic disability. Fadl is unemployed, with a major injury to his leg, he faces difficulties providing for his family.

Fadl says: "We ran away from Al-Hudaydah to Taiz to save our lives and we had nothing to bring with us. The weather in Taiz is very cold and we have no possessions, blankets, mattresses, water or cooking utensils. My children are studying, and I am unable to pay for their education. My disabled son needs diapers, milk and special food, his diet is yogurt only because he cannot eat anything else."

Mother: "I am asking for help from people to support my disabled child and provide him with winter clothes, diapers and lighting for our home. My child constantly cries all night from fear. We do not care if we sleep on the ground, but we are asking for help for my disabled son. Thank you to One Nation for visiting us and helping us through this." The pain and hardship of the war is never ending. In every neighbourhood of Taiz, dozens of families live in the same situation or have similar stories which are difficult to describe.

The Fadl family is one story amongst thousands that live through this tragedy every day.

"We ran away from Al-Hudaydah to Taiz to save our lives and we had nothing to bring with us. The weather in Taiz is very cold and we have no possessions, blankets, mattresses, water or cooking utensils. My children are studying, and I am unable to pay for their education. Bangladesh experienced an unprecedented influx of Rohingya refugees fleeing from an outbreak of violence and human rights violations in Rakhine State (Myanmar). The pace of migration made this the fastest growing refugee crisis in the world, with Cox's Bazaar hosting the world's largest refugee camp. An estimated 923,000 Rohingya refugees settled there, of which 710,000 (77%) arrived since August 2017.

Humanitarian Aid and Emergencies

Mogadishu

Appeal, Somalia *October 2017*

Emergency: A truck bomb exploded on the streets of Mogadishu killing over 300 innocent people and injuring thousands.

Response: One Nation team responded to the attacks by providing cash donations to the families, widows and orphans that were affected.

Sri Lanka

March 2018

Emergency: Muslims in parts of Sri Lanka had to endure severe attacks from anti Muslim protestors. Many homes, mosques and businesses were destroyed.

Response: One Nation provided emergency food parcels and aid to struggling families in Kandy areas.

Kerala Floods

August 2018

Emergency: Devastating floods killed more than 300 in the Indian state of Kerala, triggering landslides and sending torrents sweeping through villages in the region's worst inundation crisis in a century. 220,000 people had been left homeless.

Response: One Nation team delivered emergency aid in the Kattippara areas.

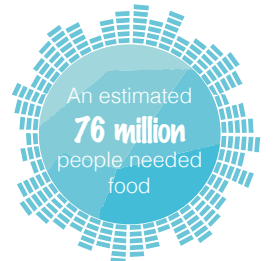


Bangladesh

June 2018

Emergency: Flash floods triggered by heavy monsoon rains killed dozens of people and displaced thousands of families in Bangladesh.

Response: One Nation delivered Emergency packs consisting of Food, water and medical aid to the displaced families in the Moulvibazar, Sylhet areas.

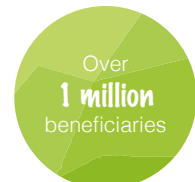


FOOD AID

There are many causes of hunger, both natural and manmade. One one of the key reasons that world

hunger is back on the increase is conflict. With your incredible support, One Nation delivered food aid in over 20 countries across Asia, Africa, Middle east and Europe. and Reaching over 1 million beneficiaries. In the cold winter months, we helped keep thousands of

families warm and safe by delivering winter clothing, heaters, fuel, blankets, in Syria, Gaza, Afghanistan and Kashmir.



GIFT OF WATER

Having access to clean drinking water should be a basic human right for everyone, yet over 1/6th of

the world's population lack access to safe drinking water to those most in need. Water pumps are funded by individual donors, this project currently operates in Bangladesh, Syria, Myanmar, India and Tanzania. We supply clean

drinking water to families in Yemen and Gaza, who depend on clean drinking water and adequate sanitation for good health and survival. Yemen is one of the world's most water-scarce countries.

PAiS

Prosthetic artificial limbs clinic in Syria

The Syrian conflict is in its seventh year, 30 000 people are injured each month and in need of medical care. There are an estimated 50,000 amputees inside Syria. PAiS offers hope for those who have lost limbs. Patients can expect to receive lightweight, strong prosthetic limbs with flexible joints in line with the highest international standards. Sadly, many of these patients are children.

8-Year-old Malak receives prosthetic leg

8-Year-old Malak receives a prosthetic leg. This is 8-year old Malak who is from Jaabiriyah, Hama. Around 2 years ago an airstrike hit Malak's home killing both her parents. She was rushed to hospital with major injuries. Malak's right leg had to be amputated.

For the past couple of years, Malak has found it difficult to go to school and play with her friends. With your donations, PAiS clinic was able to provide Malak with a prosthetic leg which has helped her walk again and feel more confident.

We were able to help Malak walk again.



Each limb costs around **£1,000** this includes assessments, fitting and rehabilitation.

PAiS center treats **30** patients a month who are treated & fitted with prosthetic limbs.

SYRIA HOSPITALS

Providing medical aid of over **£500,000**

One Nation has been assisting over 30 hospitals in Northern Syria.

We are sending aid from the UK as well as several other countries. Last year a major project was initiated, the installation of an advanced cardiac catheterization lab in one of the hospitals costing around £170,000.

Engineers from Turkey are going to Syria to complete the installation of this Cath

lab. Example of some essential hospital machines purchased and delivered:

Cholera kits Yemen

The ongoing crisis in Yemen has caused an unprecedented outbreak of cholera with more than a

million suspected cases. More than 2,000 people have died, a quarter of them children. "In just two months, cholera has spread to almost every part of this war-torn country," the United Nations said in a statement "We are now facing the worst cholera outbreak in the world".

One Nation team distributed cholera kits to Hospitals in Aden and Sana'a. Each kit contains, water purification tablets, Antibiotics, rehydration supplies and other essential items.

EDUCATION

One Nation school

Since early 2018, One Nation has been supporting an orphan school in Idlib city. The school has recruited 14 of the best, most qualified teachers across north west Syria. Their fields of expertise range from Maths, Science, fine arts, English and Arabic. The school provides hot food daily for all staff and students and have organised transportation for the students making their journey to school and back convenient and safe. A fully equipped playground was set up which has enhanced the student's recreational development.

The school has now become a vital institution for the community of Idlib city, most of the students have been orphaned or are displaced. With your continued support, we hope to continue to provide education in a secure environment for children in Syria for many years to come. (Idlib, Syria)

The school has 81 students who are receiving the finest education in Idlib city.

From the warehouse, these items are loaded in containers with other medical equipment and supplies, then sent to Syria.

With your amazing support and donations One Nation has been able to send numerous medical containers to Syria every month.

One Nation collects container aid every month from our various drop off points across the UK.

Objectives

One Nation’s objectives as a charity, whether it be an emergency or an ongoing appeal, are to conduct personal visits to oversee all projects.

This helps the charity to ensure that all needs assessments and due diligence required is conducted. Allowing One Nation’s staff to monitor how

best to utilise your donations efficiently, set short and long term aims and objectives, to check the progress of work carried out.

Bangladesh November 2017

One Nation team visited the Kutupalong camps in Bangladesh to ensure donations were used in the most efficient way. Our teams supervised

emergency aid distributions, shelter and water hand pump constructions.

Malawi December 2017

One Nation team visited Malawi, delivering food and medical aid to the most-need in the areas of Zomba, Mangochi, Ulongwe, Lilongwe and Salima.

Tanzania March 2018

One Nation created income generating projects in Dar es Salam, Tanzania. The aim was to empower families to become self-sustaining.

The following were provided:

- Block making machines: 16 families

- Eye operations: 20 people
- Tyres project: 7 families
- Juice machines: 5 families
- Dough mixers: 2 families
- Fryers: 34 families
- Paving moulds: 15 families
- Bicycles: 20 families
- Boats and fishing nets: 10 families

Our team distributed food parcels and delivered medical aid to the poor and needy.
