# SYRIA

# YEMEN

Yemen is in the middle of a major humanitarian crisis. Leaving children and families in urgent need of food, water and medical supplies. Currently, 1.71 million children are internally displaced.

80% of Yemen's population are in need of humanitarian aid and protection.

### **11.3 MILLION MALNOURISHED**




#### DID YOU KNOW?



### HOMES 4 YEMEN

Over six years into the conflict, Yemen remains the world's worst humanitarian crisis with 20.7 million people - 71% of the total population - in need of emergency assistance. The first half of 2021 continued to pose challenges to One Nation's life-saving aid projects, ranging from heavy rains destroying shelters of internally displaced populations to threatening infrastructure as well as severe malnutrition.

Along with providing vital aid through the year, One Nation has changed the lives of **over 400 families** by building homes for them as part of our Eman Village project.

# EMERGENCY AID

#### **ROHINGYA CAMP FIRE**

Thanks to your support, we have built over 60 shelters and provided food aid to the affected families of the Balukhali camp fire.

#### INDONESIA EARTHQUAKE

Our team has responded by delivering urgent food supplies, water, blankets and face masks to the affected families in the areas Koromo Hamlet, Mamuju district, West Sulawesi Indonesia.

### KONKAN FLOODS

Konkan, Maharashtra witnessed high-intensity floods due to the incessant rains in July 2021. Over 200 people died due to the floods and over 300,000 people from eight districts had to be evacuated.

Our teams supported the most needy by delivering emergency food aid, household items such as clothing, kitchen essentials and shelter kits including tarpaulin and floor mats. Thank you to all the donors for your continued support.

#### **ETHIOPIAN REFUGEES**

Our team put up temporary shelters for the Ethiopian refugee families who have been displaced in Sudan. We also distributed hot food, food parcels and kitchen utensils.

#### **BOSNIAN REFUGEES**

More than a thousand refugees were sleeping in the cold after their camp in north western town of Bihac burned down. Our team distributed over 3,000 hot meals and Blankets to the refugees in Lipa, Bihac.

### AFGHANISTAN

Over 300,000 people were displaced in 2021 due to internal conflict and nearly 23 million people (half of the population) are acutely food insecure.

One Nation has been working in Afghanistan since 2017 and our teams are responding by providing urgent support to the most needy such as -

- Monthly food aid
- Shelters for the displaced
- Medical care

- Clothing
- Hygiene kits

• Winter aid

We also built masajid, constructed water wells and continued to provide 26,000 litres of clean water every month.

## **SOUTH AMERICA**

In South America, the population of Muslim communities is growing. Approximately 1.5 million Muslims require assistance and support. Argentina, Brazil, Guyana and Mexico are the countries we currently work in. Despite the fact that we only started this year, your generous donations have allowed us to make significant progress.



#### BRAZIL

Brazil is one of the most densely populated countries in the world a population of around 212 million. Approximately 16 million of them are living in poverty and of that , (24%) 4 million of them are living on no income.

#### ARGENTINA

Argentina is a country where 40% of the population lives in poverty and this number is unfortunately only looking to increase. Only  $1/_4$  of the children in Argentina are receiving food with help of school kitchens and non-for-profit organisations and with the pandemic, this has only made the situation much worse





#### MEXICO

Around 55.7 million Mexicans are living in poverty. Food insecurity is a major problem in Mexico, around 7% of the population are surviving on \$2 a day and can't afford basic necessities. Living conditions are very extreme with families living on dirt floors, tin roofs and walls that are made from mud.

One Nation has now doubled our monthly food parcels to 200 in the last six months. These food parcels are only £25 and it contains basic necessities such as flour, oil, and salt, enough to last a month for an entire family.

We had distributed food parcels and Iftar meals in Ramadan and carried out many Qurbani's during the previous Eid's, benefiting over 1,000 families in South America. Meat is scarce in some countries and for the less fortunate, Eid will be the first time they will have eaten meat in a long time.

### **ROCHDALE OFFICE**



From October 2020 to September 2021, The Rochdale Office has raised almost half a million pounds. We have over 40 events in the last year. From biryani sales, cake auctions and street collections to car washes, football tournaments and family fun days. We have sent 2 containers during Ramadhan and Eid full of aid to those most in need in Syria. The aid consisted of non-perishable food items, medical aid, clothing and Eid gifts.

### HIGH WYCOMBE OFFICE

One Nation High Wycombe has sent 19 containers full of aid for those most in need inside Syria. Throughout the year the team were involved in arranging many events:

- Clothes 4 Syria campaign which Alhamdulillah was a huge success. We sent over 50 pallets of brand new clothes to Syria!
- Families donated Eid gifts for Syria to be distributed to those most in need inside the country.
- Ramadan Ride in aid of Iftar1000. The 23 mile bike ride went through the scenic route of the Chilterns.
- A group of brothers did the Yorkshire 3 peaks challenge to fundraise for the Iftar1000 campaign.
- One of our beloved volunteers passed away, so we setup multiple Sadaqah Jariyah projects for him, one of which was a boarding school in Syria.
- Constructed an orphanage in Zambia.
- We rehoused over 60 families in to new homes in both Syria and Yemen.
- The 313 Riders put in a great effort in supporting multiple appeals, supporting One Nation in their effort in helping the vulnerable and those most in need.

### **CONTAINER AID**

Our container aid project began to help bring communities together for a cause to serve the most needy around the world. A key focus of this is the war torn country of Syria that relies heavily on humanitarian containers across the globe.

During our last financial year we set tonnes of food, winter clothes, medical aid, energy in the form of solar panels & generators, educational items, hygiene kits/toiletries and toys to help put smiles on the faces of children who were stripped of their childhood. The value of our goods from High Wycombe alone totalled to approximately £750,000 during our last financial year.
