



Statement: Aid Delivery in Gaza

In the face of the ongoing and perilous situation in Gaza, One Nation UK stands committed to its mission of providing crucial aid and support to the innocent people of Palestine. Our four dedicated teams, operating on the ground since 2014, are actively responding to the escalating crisis.

Below is One Nation's current update on aid delivery in Gaza.

1. Funds collected are being transferred to Gaza on a regular basis to purchase emergency aid from local suppliers who have some stock remaining. Some funds are held to be used at later stages of the conflict as part of the rebuild phase. Within the charity, One Nation has scholars to ensure One Nation UK is 100% Shariah Compliant
2. Currently, there is no block on funds reaching Gaza. UK charities may have to go through different methods of getting funds into Gaza, however, One Nation UK has an office in the Gaza Strip which is still operational and receiving funds regularly.
3. One Nation UK funded our teams in Gaza prior to the conflict using unrestricted funds to support families for the coming winter months. Unrestricted funds sent across have now been allocated to be used towards the emergency aid required in the form of food, water, medical aid, hygiene kits and other basic essentials. Further funding has since been provided since the start of the conflict to support emergency aid efforts with amount continuously increasing as the appeal continues.
4. One Nation UK has 4 teams across the Gaza Strip based in Northern Gaza, Southern Gaza and 2 in Central Gaza. One Nation UK is also working alongside the Ministry of Health in Gaza at the Indonesian Hospital supporting staff member. One Nation UK teams have been operating in Gaza since 2014 and as a result of long lasting relationships with suppliers, One Nation UK are able to source supplies from within the Gaza Strip. One Nation UK are also purchasing long term aid from Egypt which will be sent into Gaza as soon as possible.

Additionally, One Nation UK has continued to provide feedback since 7th October on all social media platform, giving 100% transparency to how the aid is being distributed, our warehouse in Gaza and our efforts to saving lives in Gaza.

One Nation assesses the situation on the ground daily, to have the best possible impact to our brothers and sisters. One Nation UK aims to help rebuild Gaza and has projects in the pipeline which will provide support to individuals and families who are affected by the conflict.
