



One Nation Gaza Update – 20.12.2023

One Nation have been working in Gaza since 2014 with many staff and teams all over Gaza. Over the years, we've done various projects including food, ambulances and medical aid for hospitals, self-sustainable projects, iftar in Ramadan, rebuilding homes and much more.

Since the latest aggression in October, One Nation have had 4 teams on the ground inside Gaza. We have since expanded our work and now have 5 teams covering various areas from the north of Gaza to the south.

Just to touch on some of the ways we have been able to assist since October 2023 :

1. [Cooking hot meals](#) in our kitchens and giving ready cooked meals in UNWRA shelters and to other survivors.
2. Giving out [food packs](#) and [hygiene kits](#) especially for sisters in other areas which include [tinned food](#) etc
3. Giving out [firewood](#) so families can stay warm and also to cook food.
4. Giving our [winter clothes inside gaza](#) as many people are leaving their homes with nothing. This could literally be the difference between life and death.
5. Visiting hospitals to [give out toys](#) out to orphans and children who have survived bombings. Many children have lost loved ones but by going to see them and giving them time and love can provide a welcome distraction.
6. [Vegetables](#) and [meat distribution](#) to displaced families living in the Maghazi camp.
7. We have also had our team members risk their lives to [deliver cash](#) and medical aid on the front lines to the hospitals which are still operating including [the famous Indonesia hospital](#) which has been all over the news. This can be very risky but it's crucial for hospitals to continue operating.
8. Our teams have also been continuing our [psychological support](#) for children in shelters to try and keep their spirits high by giving them gifts, playing games and other activities. One video from 31st October [went viral on AJ+ news](#) where the team had to evacuate with the children midway through a session due to a nearby airstrike in a heavily populated residential area in Jabalia, Northern Gaza. In that one Israeli airstrike over 100 Palestinians were killed.
9. We have a team in Deir-al-Balah city, near the Maghazi camp. Where is Deir-al-Balah? If you've been following the journalist Motaz, you'll have seen the amount of [airstrikes and destruction that has been taking place in his area](#). This is one example of where our teams are [cooking hot meals and slaughtering animals](#) and giving out fresh meat to hundreds of families.
10. We have also had our trustees go to Cairo to oversee [and send trucks full of emergency hygiene packs, food boxes and water to Gaza](#). The trucks are at the Rafah border waiting in the queue with the other charity trucks and we will update everyone once they enter Gaza.
11. We understand the importance of Amanah, and we are taking extra care in distributing your donations as we are wanting to utilise them diligently for the long term. This is an ongoing assessment.
12. As the situation changes day by day, the One Nation teams are in constant dialogue as to the aid delivery and the well being of our brothers and sisters and we would like to reassure the donors that your donations are being utilised for the people of Gaza as soon as possible.
